



## storage recommendation

The rolls must always be stored horizontally, keeping them in the original packaging with an open lid, in a clean, **cool** and dry place, **avoiding exposure to dust, light and humidity.** 

## straw cleaning actions

MILD DIRT (dust): vacuum cleaner with brush nozzle and/or duster.

**DENSE DIRT (stain):** clean the area with a soft sponge (preferably the yellow side) dipped in warm water and neutral detergent. Surface dirt should come off through the foam caused by the rubbing movement of the sponge along the straw; then, use a clean, damp cloth to remove the foam already impregnated with dirt and let the straw dry naturally.

**Obs.:** In most cases the problem is solved, however, it depends on the type of product and the soaking time (we recommend immediate action after the incident). In the specific case of application on pergolas, the professional must be extremely careful when sealing the roof, avoiding any type of infiltration of rainwater (causing a dense clay that is impossible to be removed), and preventing the complete loss of the fabric and the effort put into the work."
